



COVID-19 PROTOCOL WINTER 2021-22

Effective December 13, 2021
"Outdoors Is In, <u>AND</u> Indoors Is Out!"

Song and Labrador Mountains will be strictly enforcing NYS and CDC guidelines during the winter of 2021-22. All guidelines stipulated below can change at any time without notice. DO NOT come to Song or Labrador if you are experiencing any COVID-19 or FLU like symptoms. <u>PLEASE READ PROTOCOL CAREFULLY</u> and plan accordingly.

Per Governor Hochul's mask mandate effective December 13, 2021, all employees, and patrons ages 2 and up medically able to tolerate a face covering **MUST** wear a mask at all times while indoors **EXCEPT** when physically eating or drinking.

Masks are <u>NOT</u> required while outdoors. Patrons are requested to use their best judgment and personal preferences while skiing and snowboarding. Social distancing should be practiced when appropriate. If so desired, no one will be required to share a chairlift ride. Your option to ride alone on a chairlift will not be questioned.

Per federal CDC guidance, unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks. Further, New York State and the State's Department of Health continue to strongly recommend mask-wearing in all public indoor settings as an added layer of protection, even when not required.

Your safety is our business! Don't be the reason we lose our season. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation. Be safe, be smart, and when necessary, keep 6 feet apart.
